

# Functional Area 21 - Administrative

**PSI Contract N00167-02-D-0038 DO 8:** NSWCCD has been tasked to provide support to the VIRGINIA class and SEAWOLF class programs for silencing R&D efforts. PSI supported the operation and management of the acoustic database used to support analyses and investigations in the VIRGINIA and SEAWOLF programs. PSI conducted data storage and retrieval and maintained system documentation and user guides. PSI also performed data entry, data archival, report generation, and database management.

**PSI Contract N00173-98-D-6003:** PSI provides clerical and administrative support to the Naval Research Laboratory and to NOAA's National Coastal Data Development Center (NCDDC) under the same contract. PSI's efforts support all programs within NRL's Acoustics Branch, which includes R&D for ASW, acoustic data collection and analysis, and acoustic system performance prediction modeling. PSI's efforts for NOAA support such initiatives as Homeland Security and coastal zone management/protection.

**PSI Contract N00167-02-D-0038:** PSI provides administrative support for the Fleet Numerical Meteorology and Oceanography Center (FNMOC) Science and Technology Advancement Team (STAT), which is responsible for a range of software development activities. In addition to general administrative duties, PSI's analyst is tasked with providing support for Cross Domain Solutions (CDS) and content management of the CDS web site, which directly supports PSI's tasking under ongoing Multi-Level Security projects.
